We may collect personal information in the following ways.

##### **Information you provide**

When you contact us through the website or communicate with us, we may collect:

- name
- email address
- telephone number

- any information included in your enquiry

##### **Information collected automatically**

When you visit the website, certain technical information may be collected automatically, including:

- IP address
- browser type
- device information
- pages visited
- time and date of visits

- referring website

This information helps us improve the performance and security of the website.

### **3. How We Use Personal Information**

Personal information may be used to:

- respond to enquiries
- communicate with you
- provide information about our services
- administer and improve the website
- comply with legal or regulatory obligations

We process personal information in accordance with POPIA and other applicable laws.

### **4. Cookies**

Our website uses cookies and similar technologies to improve functionality and analyse website usage.

Cookies may include:

- Strictly necessary cookies required for the website to function properly
- Analytics cookies used to understand how visitors interact with the website

When you first visit the website, you will be presented with a cookie consent banner that allows you to accept cookies, reject non-essential cookies, or customise your preferences.

Non-essential cookies are only placed on your device if you provide consent.

### **5. Sharing Personal Information**

We do not sell personal information.

Personal information may be shared with trusted service providers where necessary to operate the website, including:

- website hosting providers
- IT service providers
- analytics providers

These parties are required to protect personal information and may only process it on our instructions.

We implement reasonable technical and organisational measures to safeguard personal information against unauthorised access, loss, or misuse.

## **7. Retention of Information**

Personal information will be retained only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this policy or to comply with legal obligations.

## **8. Your Rights**

- request deletion of personal information where appropriate
- object to certain types of processing
